

Earrings

Earrings should not be worn for PE/games lessons. Earrings can create a real health and safety issue in all lessons and because of this risk we take guidance from 'The Association for Physical Education (AFPE)'

Earrings should not be worn to school on PE/games days if your child is unable to remove their earrings independently.

If for any reason your child is unable to remove their earrings then the lesson/tasks will be adapted to ensure their safety.

We would recommend that if your child is unable to remove their earrings that you consider 'taping' the earrings up. This would need to be done at home, by a parent or carer and then removed after the PE/games lesson by the child. We would still adapt a lesson/task where appropriate.

Please note that St Margaret's staff will not provide or apply tape to cover earrings.





Games day kit/uniform

On 'Games days' which are;

- Wednesday for Year 5 and 6
- Friday for Year 3 and 4

Children should wear their full St Margaret's tracksuit to school. Even if there is no fixture on that day, children should still arrive to school in their tracksuit.

If for any reason this is not possible e.g. A child left their tracksuit at school, then they can wear their school uniform to school and we will ensure that your child can change, before their games lesson or fixture.

Every other day your child should wear their school uniform to school unless they have a 'before' school club.

Children should always return home in their full school uniform unless it is their 'games day' or they have an after-school club.
